CODE OF CONDUCT 2015

Article 1.0	In conjunction with providing superior soccer training, the Canadian Academy of Futbol aspires to the highest level of personal conduct from all of CAF's participants. This is an important component in providing optimal player development conditions.
1.1	<p>In general, CAF expects ALL participants (i.e. players, coaches, game officials and spectators) to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Abstain from using abusive behavior, both physical and verbal. b) Abstain from the use of profanity. c) Abstain from the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs in the playing and spectator areas. d) Treat ALL participants with respect and to maintain self-control.
Article 2.0	<p>CAF expects COACHES to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Act as a role model for their players, demonstrating respect for fair play and good sportsmanship. b) Provide constructive feedback in order to improve the skills of their players. c) Always respect the decisions of game officials. d) Know and abide by the Laws and rules of the game. e) Arrive with their team available to play for all games and scheduled matches in accordance with CAF rules and schedules.

<p>Article 3.0</p>	<p>CAF expects PLAYERS to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Show respect for their coaches and teammates by always being prepared to play and practice at the best of their abilities. b) Protect the physical health of opponents by avoiding violence and rough play. c) Always respect the decisions of game officials. d) Know and abide by the Laws and rules of the game.
<p>Article 4.0</p>	<p>CAF expects SPECTATORS to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Support the efforts of players, coaches and game officials in a positive and constructive manner. b) Always respect the decisions of game officials.
<p>Article 5.0</p>	<p>CAF expects GAME OFFICIALS to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Officiate the game in a fair and unbiased manner. b) Follow the rules set by their governing body. c) Each academy affiliated with CAF is responsible for ensuring that it`s coaches, players and spectators adhere to these policies.
<p>Article 6.0</p>	<p>Teams that do not comply with the CAF Code of conduct are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Subject to fines, discipline and Academy Sanctions b) Accountable to all OSA policies pertaining to discipline, games and fines.
